School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) Composition

1 School Board shall appoint at least five members to the committee, including one: teacher, clergy, law enforcement, business member, senior citizen, representatives of non – profit health organizations, or student.

2 The majority of the members should be parents and students.

3 One of these members shall be appointed as the co – chair.

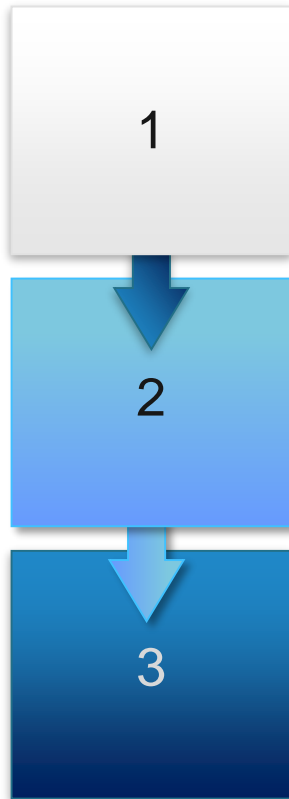
